Traveling with TRICARE Prime?

- Urgent Care is not the same as emergency care. Urgent care to treat a condition that doesn't threaten life, limb or eyesight, but needs attention before it becomes a serious risk to health (i.e. fever, sprained ankle) You must contact your current PCM for a referral when traveling.
- Call the Nurse Advise Line (NAL) 24/7 provides healthcare advise
 - Beneficiary who receives care at a military installation NAL notifies PCM of what was advised
 - Beneficiary who receives care from a civilian PCM provides directions for obtaining a referral or prior authorization

Emergency Care – Requires immediate medical treatment

- Call 911, seek emergency care
- Call your PCM within 24 hours or the next business day

TRICARE's Breast Pump Policy Updates Effective July 1

- Policy was recently updated to include coverage of breast pumps and supplies and breastfeeding supplies. These supplies and services will be retroactively covered as of December 19, 2014.
- To get full details about this important benefit change, as well as an opportunity to ask questions, TRICARE will host a Facebook Town Hall on June 22, 2015, 1:00 pm EDT.
- To be covered, the breast pump and supplies must be obtained form a TRICARE authorized provider, supplier or vendor.
- For manual or standard electric breast pumps and associated supplies (includes breast pump kits), this includes nay civilian retail store or pharmacy. If the beneficiary pays out of pocket for a covered breast pump, submit a completed claim form with a copy of the prescription for the breast pump along with your receipt for reimbursement.
